#### **ActivStudio**



This is the main toolbar in ActivStudio. To activate the Desktop Overlay, click on this button.

Then choose Desktop Overlay.



This will place a transparency over the desktop of your computer. It will allow you to annotate over the live desktop.


This means you can work with:

- Websites
- Word Documents
- PDFs
- Any application you have open on your computer, with the exception of PowerPoint on the Mac

#### **ActivStudio**

Once you have turned on the Desktop Overlay, you will see a narrow gray border which indicates that the overlay is on.

Below is an example of using the Desktop Overlay with a website.





Annotations made over the website with the ActivStudio pen and highlighter.

#### **ActivStudio**

When using the Desktop Overlay, you will need to clear annotations as you move from one page to another, or as you scroll up/down or left/right within a document.

In the example below, we scrolled down on the page, but the annotations stayed in the same spot on the screen.






### ActivStudio

If you want to flip back and forth between a flipchart and the Desktop Overlay, you would click the Hide/Show Flipchart button to bring up the flipchart and then use the Desktop Annotate button to go back to your desktop.



Click here to show your flipchart. This is the Show/ Hide Flipchart button.



Click here and select Desktop Overlay to return to the transparency on your desktop.
